



## Summer Program Guidelines

### Employee Screening & Training

- All RRC teaching staff have been fully vaccinated.
- Daily temperature checks of RRC staff are required prior to working.
- Our staff has been trained on all our safety protocols for both on and off court.

### Student Screening

- Students will be screened at drop-off while in their cars. This may include daily temperature checks using no touch forehead thermometers and a quick check of symptoms.
- Any student exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, either upon arrival, or at any point during the day, will be isolated from other students until a parent or guardian arrives to pick them up.
- Parents: please keep your child home if he/she exhibits any sign of illness.

### Mask Policy

- Masks are optional for indoor and outdoor tennis and other outdoor activities (with the exception of our 8 & Under Program, where masks are required during class time).
- Masks must be worn when in any indoor areas (besides on the tennis court), including club lobby and restrooms.
- For our 8 & Under, Red Ball students, masks can be removed during outdoor break times and outdoor activities.

### Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures

- Drop-off begins at 8:30am for the Morning Session. Please arrive no later than 8:45am.
- Staff will be positioned throughout the parking lot to help guide the flow of cars.
- At drop-off, parents/guardians/nannies must remain in their cars, so that staff members can greet, conduct the temperature checks, and escort students to their designated group area.
- If your child is having trouble separating, you will be directed to a designated parking area so that you can take the time to transition your child.
- Parents/guardians/nannies will not be permitted to remain on the premises.
- Pick up time - parents/guardians/nannies please remain in cars. Staff members will bring your child directly to your vehicle once you are at the pick-up area.

### Student Class Time

- We will have small groups of 10 students or less who will work with the same 2-3 pros throughout the week.
- Interaction between groups will be minimal and social distancing will be maintained at all times.
- Break times will be staggered as needed to avoid large group gatherings.
- The pro staff will make sure students are practicing safety protocols while still maintaining a fun, positive learning experience!

### Student Check List – All items should be clearly labeled with student's name.

- Racquet (we do not have demo racquets available, so please do not forget!!)
- Water bottle. Water bottle fillers and coolers will be available throughout the facility. Bottled water is also available for purchase - \$1 (exact change please).
- Snack – must be in an insulated lunch cooler (we don't have a lunch time, but a short snack time mid-morning). There are snacks available for purchase through Tennis Professionals (the pro shop on premises).

- Hat/visor and/or sunglasses.
- Sunscreen (Please apply prior to coming to the club. Sunscreen will not be available at the club).
- Mask.
- Small towel (for older students).
- Small backpack to store above mentioned items.
- An *ice cream truck* will visit the facility every Thursday! Students should bring cash if they wish to purchase.
- Pizza will be provided by the Club on Fridays. If you do not wish your child to be served pizza, please let us know. Students are also welcome to bring their own snack or lunch.

#### Sanitary Practices

- Hand sanitizers containing at least 60% alcohol and disinfectant wipes will be available on each court as well as around the break areas and throughout the facility.
- Baskets, on-court equipment, chairs and all high touch areas will be disinfected throughout the day.
- The facility is cleaned and sanitized thoroughly each morning by a professional cleaning company.

#### Facility

- We will have several large tents set up around the parking lot and back area. For break times, groups of 10 players or less will use a designated tent or other outside area.
- After drop-off time, the main parking lot will be closed off until pickup time.
- iWave air-purifying devices are installed in the HVAC system on our indoor courts. This advanced technology creates a healthier environment by reducing viruses, pathogens, allergens and other particles in the air and on surfaces without producing any harmful byproducts.
- On cooler days when we don't use the indoor court HVAC system, all 3 doors on the courts will remain open. Additionally, there are 2 large exhaust fans on either end of the courts which help circulate the air.

#### Rainy Days

- On rainy days, students will remain in their groups and seek cover under our tents. We will still have the use of our indoor courts. Break times will continue to be staggered to avoid gatherings in any one area. Pros will organize group fitness & other fun activities, in addition to indoor tennis. Indoor lobby space will only be utilized on a limited basis, in which case masks must be worn.

#### Protocols in the Event of a positive COVID-19 case

- We will follow the Westchester County Department of Health guidelines.

#### Parents/Guardians/Nannies

- Health forms must be submitted online prior to the start of the session.
- In order to keep the flow of drop off moving efficiently, we cannot answer multiple questions in the drop off zone. If you would like to wait in a designated area away from the drop off zone, a staff member will direct you accordingly and answer all questions. If possible, please email any questions ahead of time.
- We cannot permit parents/guardians/nannies to remain on the premises during the tennis sessions.
- Please reinforce our safety protocols with your child prior to attending. In the event your child is unable to adhere to the Club's safety guidelines for any reason, we will need to remove your child from our program.

As always, we welcome your feedback and any concerns you may have. We have been continuously monitoring and updating our protocols and facility for everyone's safety. The pros are ready to make each class a very memorable and fun tennis experience for your child(ren). At all times, our ultimate goal is creating an enjoyable, safe learning space for all students.
